<p>Step 1: Examine the photograph for 10 seconds. How would you describe the photograph?</p>	
<p>Step 2: Divide the photograph into quadrants and study each section individually. What details – such as people, objects, activities – do you notice?</p>	
<p>Step 3: What other information – such as time period, location, season, reason photo was taken – can you gather from the photo?</p>	
<p>Step 4: How would you revise your first description of the photo using the information noted in Steps 2 and 3?</p>	
<p>Step 5: What questions do you have about the photograph? How might you find answers to these questions?</p>
